Interns will be selected, for a period of one year and assign a lead mentor at the organization and will have the opportunity to work with several senior staff members over the course of the program. They will be expected to make substantive contributions to the work of the organization, including preparing reports, drafting letters, attending meetings and conferences, and participating in other activities of the organisation.
